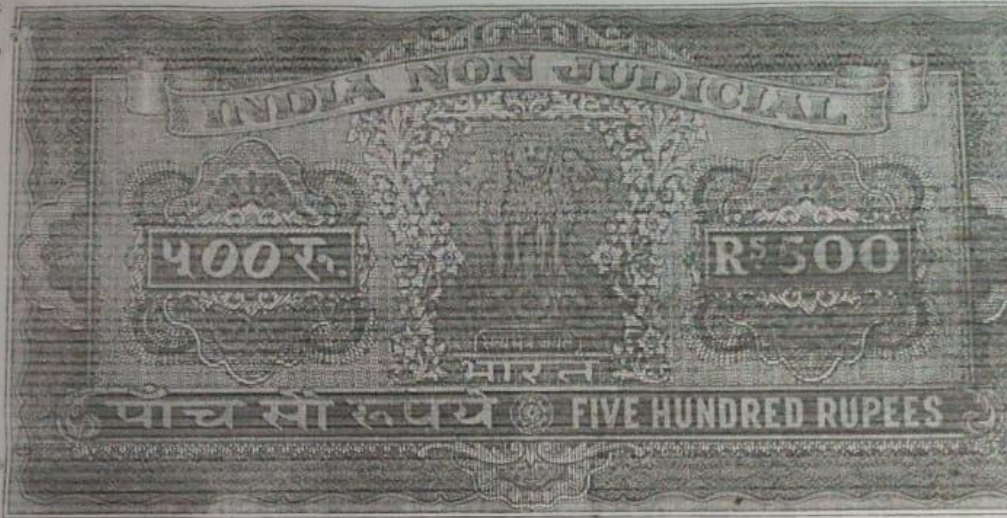

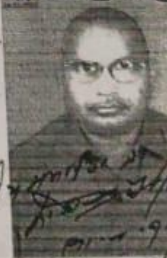

"TRUST DEED"

**S.R.M. EDUCATIONAL TRUST
 BANKA, (BIHAR)**



THIS TRUST DEED is made this... 31st Jan, 2006... between Mr. RAIBNDRA KUMAR SINGH, S/O LATE KHUBLAL SINGH, Agriculturalist at Rajpur Banka herein after called the SETTLER (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include the settler's executory, administrative and representative of the AID

- (i) Mr. Rabindra Kumar Singh as aforesaid
- (ii) Smt. Mandakini Singh, D/o Shri Anant Pd. Singh, Pawai, Bhalva Banka by Caste Hindu Sukhnagar, Purnea.

1. In order to effectuate the said desire the settler has made to the Trustees a sum of rupees Five thousands only each introduce the initial Capital for the purpose of establishment of trust and if required the additional fund introduced for the objects and purpose herein contained concerning the same.
2. The name of the Trust shall be S.R.M. EDUCATIONAL TRUST
3. The object for which the Trust is established as education, relief of the poor. Details of the objects of Trust given as below :-
 - a) S.R.M. EDUCATIONAL TRUST has been organised to establish, maintain or grant aid in cash or kind to school for children/to Hospital, Medical Colleges, Nursing institution, sanctioned charitable and / or travelling dispensaries, Minority Homes, Children care Home, Children Welfare Centre, Children parks, Widows Homes or similar charitable institution for the benefit of students and for the benefit of public in general.
 - b) To established, support, maintain, acquire, run, and/or grant aid and other financial assistance of PATHSHALAS, SCHOOLS, COLLEGES, LIBRARIES, READING ROOMS, HOSTELS, BOARDING HOUSE, LABORATORIES, and other institution of like nature for use of the students and staff and also generally for development and/or advancement of educational and diffusion or knowledge amongst the public in general.
 - c) To establish maintain and/or run studentship scholarship and other kind or add to needily pupils including supply or books, stipends, medals, and other incentives to study and to provide board and residence for poor general.
 - d) To establish, maintained grant aid to home orphanages or other establishment for relief and to give help to the poor and distinguish people, orphans, old people, widow etc.
 - (e) To provide relief during natural calamities such as famine, drought, earthquake, flood, fire, cyclone and other occasions of calamities subscription or contribution to institution, funds, establishment or persons carrying on such relief work.
 - (f) To render assistance and/or aid to recognised public charitable trust or institution.
 - (g) To promote and undertake programmes for moral & mental development of women, youth and children of all Communities.
 - (h) To organise Seminar, Meeting, Debates, Conference & Workshop for the purpose of education, Health, awareness, consumer right, Human rights panchayati Raj and other activities for public welfare time to time.
 - (i) To plant all types of trees beside the road side and vacant land for protection of environment and pollution control and give knowledge about non-energy, Solar energy, Water energy, Air energy and provide time to time for rural people and minority people.

- (j) To establish Cancer Hospital, Physical Education Centre, Maternity Centre, Blood Donation Centre, Eye Centre, Blind School, Vaccination Centre, Family Planning Centre, Leprosy Centre, Drug Edict Centre and give knowledge about AIDS, Cancer, Kalazar, such time to time and aware people in the field also run and manage Research Centre in the Society.
- (k) To Setup a frame work for alternative schooling between VI to XIV age group Child not getting main strips of primary school education such as sex weaker child, right victim child, weavers child, SC & ST child, Mushar child, Santhali child etc.
- (l) To promote true and treat and fairness communication, publication, cultural and other welfare programmes sponsored by the private or public or central or state govt.
- (m) To develop water resources programmes, modern cultivation and setup an small scale industries for independently of the people.
- (n) To help in Physical growth & proficiently of the people in music, dances, drawing, painting, games & sports, Judo & Carate and Indian dramas, etc.
- (o) To do every possible programmes for nationality & intergraty.
- (p) To do every possible work for the protection of all living beings including animal & birds.
- (q) To cooperate with the other organisation having similar aims & interest and also provides opportunities for communication between themselves.
- (r) To do any other act for the achievement of general public utility not involving the carrying on or any activity for profit.
- (s) To do any other act for the advancement of general public utility not involving on or any activities for benefit without distribution of caste, clour & Creed.
- (t) To do all such things as may be deemed necessity by the Board of Trustee of the Trust from time to time in attainment of the objectives and programmes schemes introduced by the govt. or private authority.

The Trustees shall cause true and correct accounts to be kept of all money received and spent and/or all materials in respect there of in cause of management of Trust fund or in relation to the carrying out or the objects and purpose of the Trust as well as of all the aspects, credits and efforts of the trust fund.

For all furthering of objects of the Trust, The Trustees will have the following powers which will be exercised by them in accordance with the provisions of the Income-Tax Act 1961 and the Income Tax Rules 1962 inform from time to time.

- (a) To accept any donation, contribution grant or subscription for the Trust.

To invest and keep invested the trust fund for the purchase or mortgage of immovable property including flat or in share or stock or debenture. On other securities and investments whether authorised by the Indian Trust Act 1882 of or not or in deposit with on lease to any company, bank, firm on any other persons in conformity with the provision of the Income Tax Act for the time being informed and alter, vary or transpose much investments from time to time as the trustees may in their discretion think fit for others of the same or alike or different nature.

- (c) To borrow or secure payment of money and also to lend money either with or without security.
- (d) To accept Loan (C/C, T.L., O/D etc) from any nationalised Bank & other financial Institution and any other private agency, If required for establishment of any type of work for benefit of the trust on the basis of approval of the board of trustee.
- (e) To sell, dispose off any property comprising the Trust fund.
- (f) To open accounts with any bank, to operate such account and to give institutions to the Bank and to provide for the opening and operation of such accounts by one or more of Trustees or by agent appointed by the trustees.
- (g) To appoint Constituted Attorney or Agent and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the periods vested in them.
- (h) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart and charity or charitable institution or organisation for the benefit or general public & to improve and conditions to any subscription on donation made by them.
- (i) To join/cooperate this trust with others having hindred or allied object upon such terms and conditions as Trustees may in their description and nature of this Trust.

Subject to such rules & regulation the Trustees may be time to time think fit on the following points :-

- (i) To make very alter or modality schemes, rules and regulation for carrying out . The object of the Trust and to the management of the affairs there of and running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the object of the Trust.
- (ii) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or Charitable Institution for the benefit of general public.
- (iii) To get apart or accumulate the whole or part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part there of for any subscription or donation made by them.
- (iv) The receipt or a pension authorised by the Trustee or a resolution of the Board of Trust for any money paid or any property transferred to be delivered to the trustee must be approved by the Board of Trustee.
- (v) The Trustee will not be entitled to receive any remuneration but may reimburse themselves or all the expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.

The number of Trustee shall not be less than Two and more than nine.

The Trustee for the time being will be liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment as the Trustee for the time being consider proper.

If any Trustee dies, retires, become unfit or incapable to act in continuing. So, the Trustee will be competent to appoint a Trustee in place of the dying, retiring or becoming unfit or incapable to act. Every Trustee will be liberty to resign on giving one months notice or him/her intention to do.

On the basis of such regulation :-

- (a) Two Trustee shall form a quorum for ammounting of Trustees.
- (b) All matter will be decided by majority.
- (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of Trustee shall not be valied.

The Head office of the Trust shall be situated at Bhagalpur. It may be changed in other place of Bhagalpur or any other place of the state of Bihar, Jharkhand and others.

Unless changed by the Trustees by 2/3 majority.

The accounting year or the financial year will be April to 31st March. Unless charged by the Trustee by 2/3 majority.

Inspector general of registration Bihar / Registrar, Bhagalpur on his discretion any time may get audited the trust by a recognised chartered accountant and the fee for the same will be borne by the trust.

The Trust hereby created shall be imarkable.

It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property on its income or Trust shall be applied for any other purpose with in India or outside of India or for any purpose not accepted by Law and all provisions hereby shall be constructed accordingly.

Any addition, alteration or ommission in the objects and rules & regulations of the turst shall be effected by the resolution of the trust by 2/3 majority of the turst at a special meeting of trust.

Before dissolution of the trust the state government concent will be octent under the trust registration act & after dissolution there remain any property movable or immovable after satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, the property so left shall not be paid or distributed among the member of the tursty but shall be given by some other turst or society or the government to be determined by the votes of not less than 3/5 of the member of trust present in person at the time of dissolution.

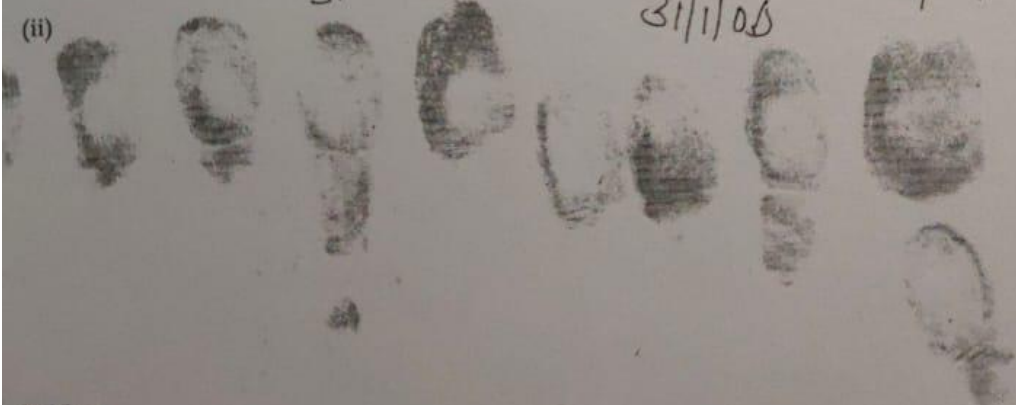
